Discipleship is to take people from knowing Jesus to living Jesus...




My family and those close to me.

The essence of discipling mine.

"You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden." "Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house." "In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven." (Mat 5:14-16, NIV)

Mine.(discipling through example)

Mine. (Discipling through transparency)

Mine. (Discipling through accountability)

Mine. (Discipling through repentance)

Mine. (Discipling through seasons 0-5)

- 1. Emotionally **stable environment** for mother and child
- 2. Intimacy through breast feeding, hugging and intimate eye contact
- 3. Brain boosting through reading and games.
- 4. Nurture and care(speak emotions; careful of separation angst)
- 5. Develop basic life skills and competencies.


Mine. (Discipling through seasons 6-12)

- 1. Affirmation by father to establish unique significance
- 2. Consciousness of **Spiritual** reality grows
- 3. Sex education needed before sexual development starts.
- 4. Emotion regulating skills needed to cope with emotional stress.
- 5. Clear sense of personal **Identity** needed.

Mine. (Discipling through seasons 12-18)

- 1. Sexual development must be processed
- 2. TEAM-age years need relational skills
- 3. Peer pressure asks for emotional processing
- 4. Emotional intelligence should be acquired
- 5. Leadership skills should be developed
