





Mat 3:2 (NLT) "Repent of your sins and turn to God, for the Kingdom of Heaven is near."

Mat 3:8 (NIV) Produce fruit in keeping with repentance.




They can care for one person – themselves. "I need" is prominent








Can stay true to yourself despite distress, Stable, strong identity





Heb 10:25 (NLT) And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but encourage one another, especially now that the day of his return is drawing near.



They help others to thrive, love well. Don't live for themselves








Take others under the wing, Lives with next generation in mind








Earry the fruit of your repentance
