

EXO 24:16-17 NLT

And the glory of the LORD settled down on Mount Sinai, and the cloud covered it for six days. On the seventh day the LORD called to Moses from inside the cloud. To the Israelites at the foot of the mountain, the glory of the LORD appeared at the summit like a consuming fire.

EXT 40:34-35 NLT

Then the cloud covered the Tabernacle, and the **glory of the LORD** filled the Tabernacle. Moses **could no longer enter** the Tabernacle because the cloud had settled down over it, and the glory of the LORD filled the Tabernacle.

2 Chron 7:1-2 NLT

When Solomon finished praying, fire flashed down from heaven and burned up the burnt offerings and sacrifices, and the **glorious presence of the LORD** filled the Temple. The priests **could not enter** the Temple of the LORD because the glorious presence of the LORD filled it.

70h 18:4-6 NLT


IN JESUS



"Lord, your dear friend is very sick."



So although Jesus loved Martha, Mary, and Lazarus, he stayed where he was for the next two days.



But his disciples objected. "Rabbi," they said, "only a few days ago the people in Judea were trying to stone you. Are you going there again?"



The disciples said, "Lord, if he is sleeping, he will soon get better!"



Thomas, nicknamed the Twin, said to his fellow disciples, "Let's go, too—and die with Jesus."



When Jesus arrived at Bethany, he was told that Lazarus had already been in his grave for four days.



Martha said to Jesus, "Lord, if only you had been here, my brother would not have died.






WHEN THERE ARE TEARS






WHEN THERE IS DOUBT

Lazarus from dying?"






WHEN THERE IS RESISTANCE
