

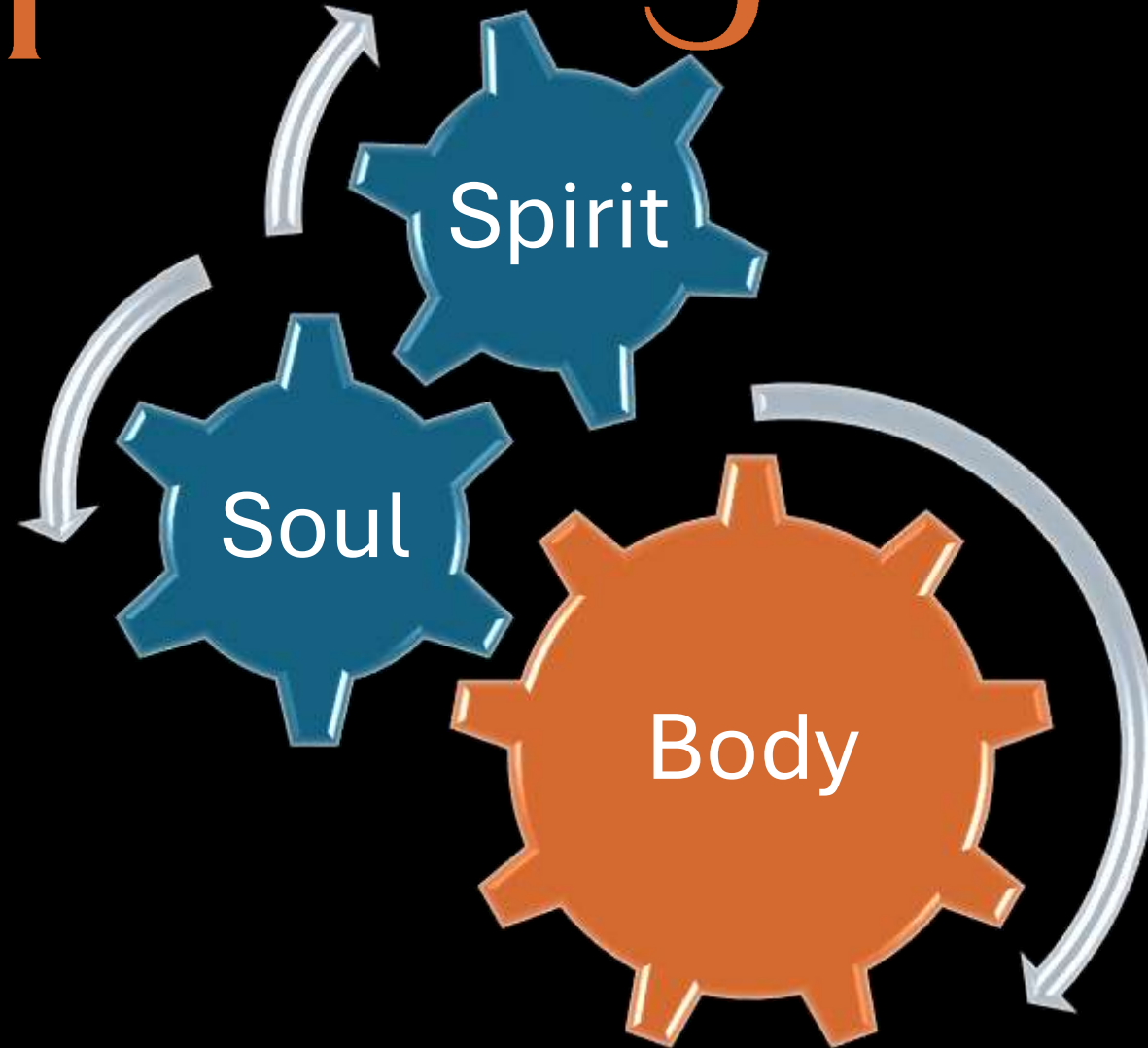

Mind-Body Connection

In psychology, the mind-body connection refers to the dynamic interactive relationship between mental and emotional states and physical health. It acknowledges that our thoughts, feelings and beliefs can directly influence our bodily functions and processes, and that our physical health can directly impact our mental and emotional well-being.

Instrument for Glory

Run from sexual sin! No other sin so clearly affects the body as this one does. For sexual immorality is a sin against your own body. Don't you realize that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit, who lives in you and was given to you by God? You do not belong to yourself, for God bought you with a high price. So you must honor God with your body.

Live as children of obedience [to God]; do not conform yourselves to the evil desires [that governed you] in your former ignorance [when you did not know the requirements of the Gospel]. But as the One Who called you is holy, you yourselves be holy in all your conduct and manner of living.
