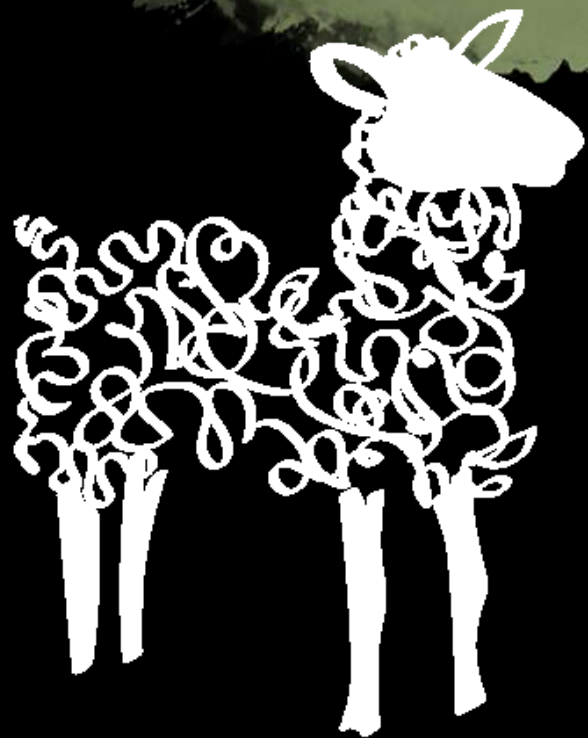

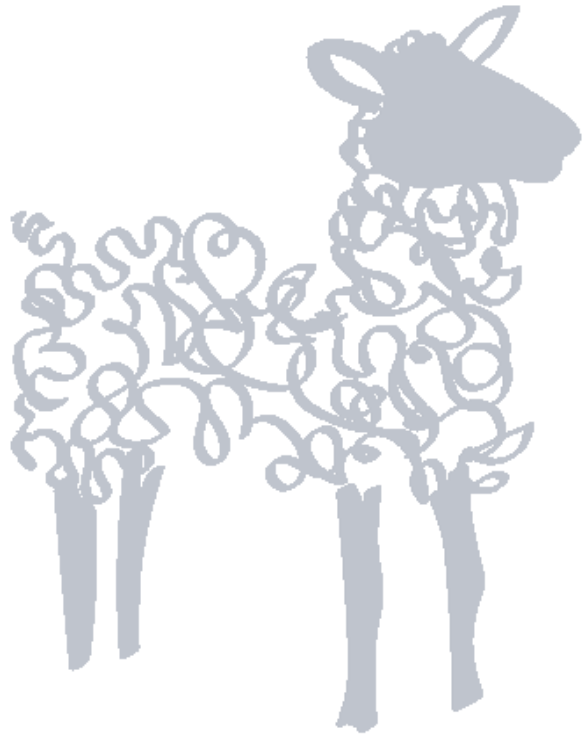
Abounding grace
