He *loved us* and offered himself as a sacrifice for us, a pleasing aroma to God.

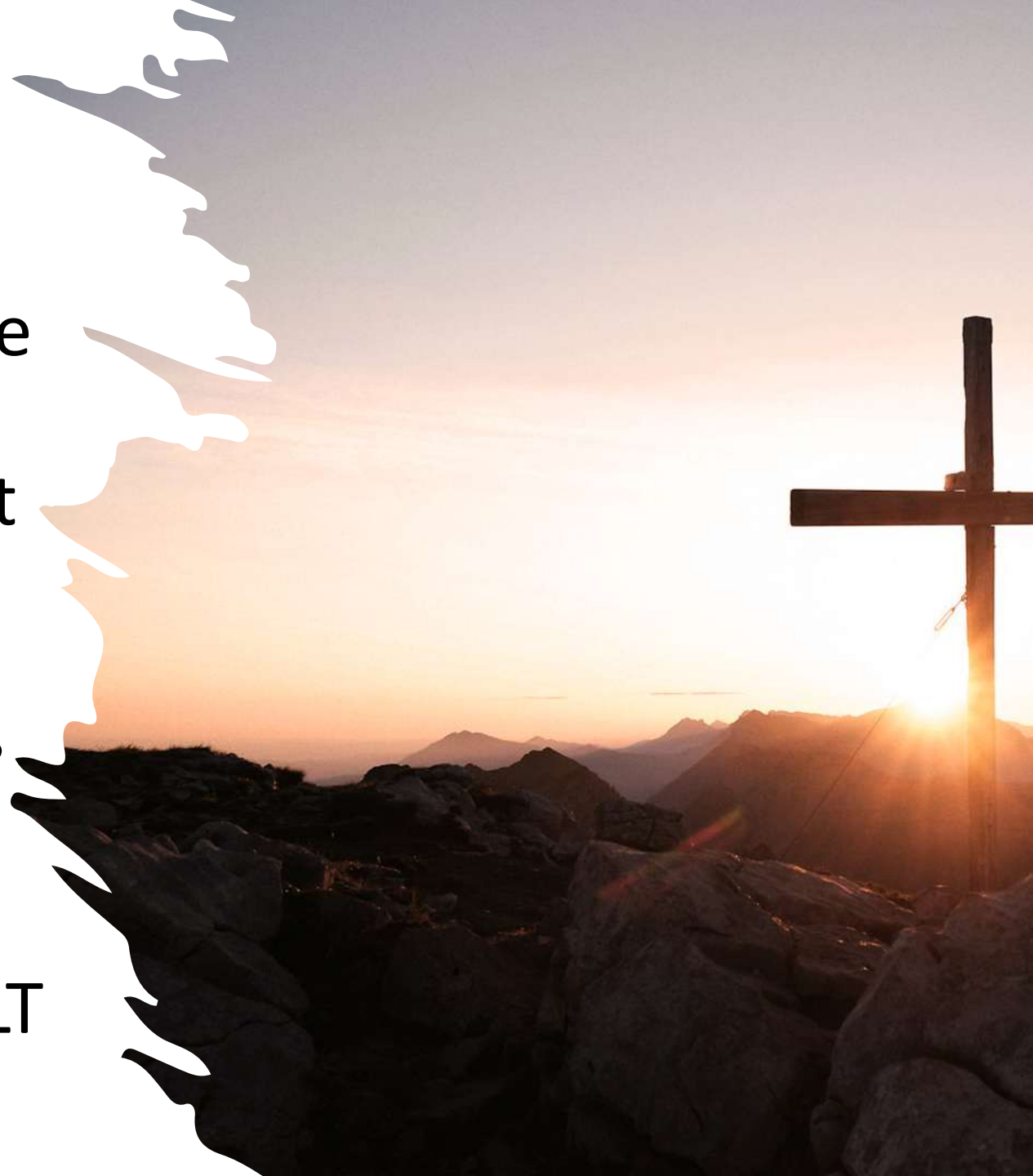

Heb 10:19 NLT




# All things
